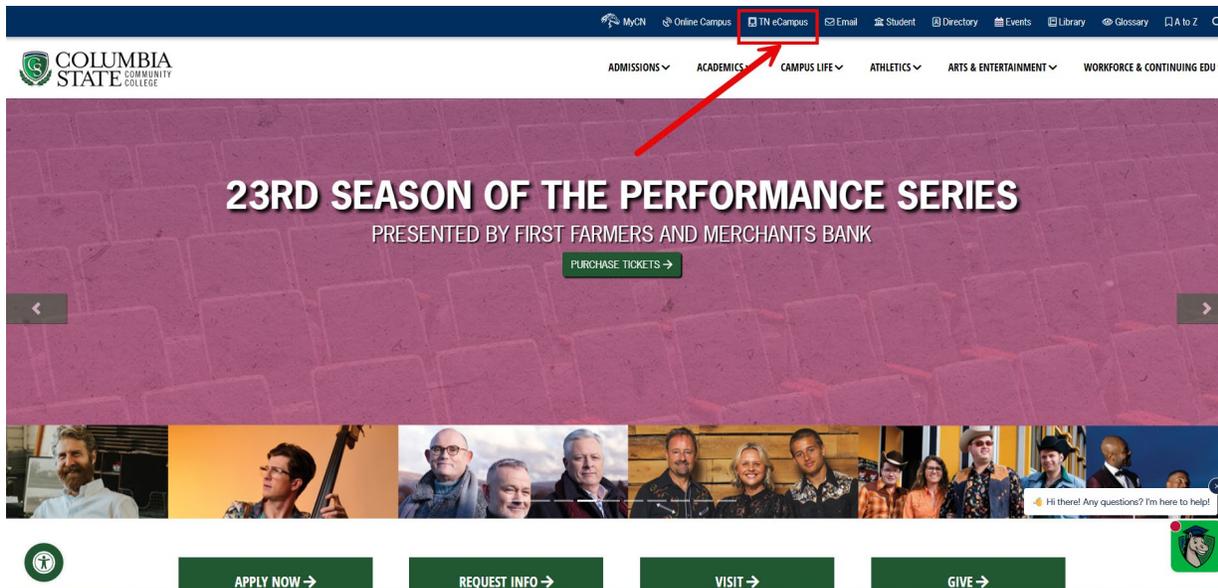




How to Login to TN eCampus courses

Welcome to your TN eCampus courses at Columbia State Community College! Please see below for helpful information about how to log into your TN eCampus courses.

1. Navigate to the [Columbia State Community College](#) homepage and go to the top navigation bar and select, “TN eCampus.”



2. From here, you'll be taken to the TN eCampus main login page. Scroll down to the bottom to see where to input your name and password. Use the credentials that you receive from TN eCampus. The credentials will be sent to your @columbiastate.edu campus email address.

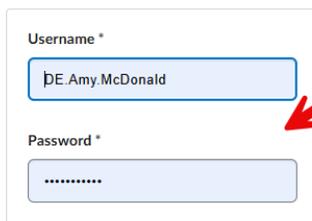
