## National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) Pass Rates

**Program Outcome #1** - Performance on Licensure Exam: the annual NCLEX-RN pass rate for first time takers will meet accreditation and state requirements. (ACEN: 80%; TBON: 80%)

## Nursing Program Completion Rate

**Program Outcome #2** - Program Completion:

- Forty-five percent (45%) of all students who begin in the first NRSNG course in the traditional option will complete the AAS in Nursing curriculum in 4 academic semesters.
- Forty-five percent (45%) of all students who begin in the first NRSNG course in the LPN-to-RN Career Mobility option will complete the AAS in Nursing curriculum in 3 academic semesters.
- Sixty percent (60%) of all students who begin the first NRSNG course in the traditional and LPN-to-RN Career Mobility options will complete the program within one hundred-fifty percent (150%) of the program length. (traditional: 6 semesters; LPN-to-RN:4 semesters)
