

Instructional Design Team – IDT

The Instructional Design Team is made up of Columbia State faculty proficient in the pedagogy of online teaching and course design. Columbia State follows a 3-review model consisting of an instructional and accessibility review, completed by the Instructional Development Specialist; IDT review, completed by a faculty IDT member; and a final review completed by the Director of Distance Education.

Member Term

At least One Academic Year

Qualifications

- Members must have developed an online course.
- Members must be proficient in using the current Learning Management System.
- It is preferred that the members have taken an online course as a student.

Requirements

- Members must attend an “Introduction to IDT” training session.
- Members must attend a bi-monthly meeting delivered on-ground and DVC.

Duties

- Provide guidance and feedback throughout the online course development process using the Quality Assurance rubrics.
- Assure the course complies with all Columbia State quality standards.
- Complete course evaluations promptly so the course can be added to the schedule of classes.
- Complete the Peer Review form and submit the completed form to the Director of Distance Education.
