Columbia State Community College will hold its annual High School Competition on **Friday, March 20, 2026**. The intention of these contests is to attract talented students to our campus. As part of these contests, the Music Department is sponsoring a vocal and piano contest for soloists only (no duets, trios, quartets, etc.) Each student will be judged on his/her overall interpretation. **Registration from your school must be received by March 6, 2026. Pre-registration is required for both the Piano Competition and the Vocal Competition. No late registrations will be accepted.**

Below lists special instructions specifically related to the Piano Competition as well as special instructions specifically related to the Vocal Competition. **Please note:** New guidelines for the music competitions were implemented in spring 2016. Please read the following information carefully. Be sure to send the repertoire titles and composers/arrangers with each student's entry.

**PIANO COMPETITION**

- 1) Begins at 9:10 a.m. in the Cherry Theater Piano
- 2) Performances should last no more than **five (5) minutes** length.
- 3) A piano will be provided for the piano students to perform on stage.
- 4) Each piano student will be judged on the following criteria:  
technique, rhythmic precision and interpretation, according to the difficulty of the music and stage presence.

5) **Be sure to send the repertoire titles and composers/arrangers with each student's entry.**

#### **VOCAL COMPETITION**

1) Begins immediately after the piano competition. The last vocal student will be accepted at 11:35 a.m. **The music competitions end at 11:40 a.m.**

2) Performances should last no more than ***five (5) minutes*** length.

3) Due to the traditionally high volume of vocal entries, only pre-registered entries may perform for the competition.

4) **Important: The vocal competition will ONLY include art songs or Broadway songs. Be sure to send the repertoire titles and composers/arrangers with each student's entry.**

5) A piano will be provided for vocal performances. **Vocal Students must provide their own accompanist.** Students may use pre-recorded music.

During the awards ceremony that afternoon, awards for the vocal and piano competition will be given to first, second and third place winners by decision of the judges.
