## Lipscomb University Nursing

Students successfully completing the Bachelor of Science in Nursing will have a total of 128 credits. Students complete the last 4 semesters of the program in a cohort model.

Students must meet the following criteria and successfully complete an admissions interview for acceptance consideration. Interviews are conducted by invitation only.

**A. Pre-requisite Science Courses:** Students must obtain a “B” average in all **five** of the pre-requisite science courses (listed below) before beginning the Lipscomb University School of Nursing program in the fall.

- Microbiology + Lab
- Anatomy and Physiology I + Lab
- Anatomy and Physiology II + Lab
- Introduction to Human Pathophysiology - TN eCampus online
- General Chemistry I OR Introduction to Chemistry I - TN eCampus online

**B. Pre-requisite Nursing Courses:** Student must obtain “C” or higher in all the required pre-requisite nursing courses (listed below) before beginning the Lipscomb University School of Nursing program in the fall.

- Principles of Nutrition
- General Psychology
- Life Span Psychology
- Abnormal Psychology
- Elementary Statistics
- Medical Terminology

**C.** Applicants must have at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA in their pre-requisite course work for the nursing program.

**D.** Failure to meet the pre-requisite requirements will result in the delay of a student’s admission into the fall cohort of the Lipscomb University School of Nursing program. **A “B” average in the FIVE pre-requisite science courses and a grade of “C” or higher in the pre-requisite nursing courses must be achieved before entering the Lipscomb University School of Nursing program.**
